CHARACTER AND FITNESS

Because of the high ethical standards to which lawyers are held, the failure to disclose an act or event such as the ones described below is often more significant, and leads to more serious consequences, than the act or event itself. Past criminal history will not automatically bar admission. Failure to provide truthful answers, or failure to inform the Office of Law Admissions of any changes to your answers, may result in revocation of admission or disciplinary action by the law school, or denial of permission to practice law by the state in which you seek admission to the bar. We strongly urge, if you are unsure as to whether to make a disclosure, that you err on the side of disclosure. Inconsistencies between your application to the bar and your application for admission to law school may prevent you from being admitted to the bar. It is your responsibility to update your application by notifying the Loyola Office of Law Admissions of any disciplinary charges that are filed or are expected to be filed between the date you submit this application and the date you enroll at Loyola. Your obligation to disclose continues throughout your entire tenure at Loyola University New Orleans College of Law.

In addition to a bar examination, there are character, fitness, and other qualifications for admission to the bar in every U.S. jurisdiction. Applicants are encouraged to determine the requirements for any jurisdiction in which they intend to seek admission by contacting that jurisdiction. Addresses for all relevant agencies are available through the National Conference of Bar Examiners.
