## **Instructions for Public Service Requirement:**

Each student seeking the Social Justice Certificate must complete 50 hours of public service work. The work must be pre-approved by Professor Judson Mitchell. Public service work is broadly defined to include work performed for a stipend, in addition to pro bono work. Pro bono hours completed to satisfy the Law and Poverty requirement may also be used to satisfy this requirement; Professor Mitchell's approval is required. All public service hours completed for the certificate, both compensated and uncompensated, must be reported through the Pro Bono Reporting database, online at <a href="http://loyolalawtech.org/probono/">http://loyolalawtech.org/probono/</a>.

Effective fall 2016, the faculty voted to create a separate course called LAW L976 Environmental Policy and Advocacy, which had been taught in the LAW L886 Environmental Law Seminar series with the section name Environmental Policy Advocacy. This course will appear on transcripts as LAW L976 if taken fall 2016 or onward. These are the same courses and both satisfy this requirement.
